Lectures

- An annual lecture programme of early evening lectures every month from October to June, with talks by well-known scholars and local experts
- Meetings are on the Sidgwick site, an accessible central Cambridge venue with free car parking

Conferences

- All-day spring conference
- An autumn exhibition and conference centred on the most recent archaeological work in Cambridgeshire

Publications

- *Proceedings of the Cambridge Antiquarian Society*, published annually, contains the latest information on local archaeological discoveries and includes architecture, local history and other antiquarian topics
- *Conduit* lists lecture programmes, local societies and heritage events in the county each year

Other activities

- A summer excursion programme, led by experts
- We arrange visits to excavations and notify members of imminent lectures and other events and news by email
- We arrange occasional college meals, garden parties and other social events

Library

Collections

- CAS collections provided the original core of the *University Museum of Archaeology and Anthropology*
- *Cambridgeshire Collection*, Central Library, Lion Yard houses over 8000 CAS photographs
- *Cambridgeshire Archives* holds nearly 3000 CAS lantern slides of Cambridgeshire
- *The Cambridge University Library* keeps CAS' early 19th century Relhan Collection of over 350 watercolours of Cambridgeshire, and an extensive collection of monumental brass rubbings
